## How to Replace Wax Guards

Remove tip (dome) earpiece.



## Open the package of wax guards

The CeruSTOP<sup>TM</sup> wax guard system consists of the following parts:



A white wax guard is mounted on one end of the holder. At the other end is a hook for removing the used wax guard.

- 1. Remove one stick from the package.
- 2. Push the removal hook gently and straight into the old wax guard until you feel a click. Pull gently. The old wax guard will come out on the stick.
- 3. Turn the stick over end for end so that the new wax guard is lined up with the hole (gray loudspeaker) where the old one was removed.
- 4. Push the new wax guard into the hole (receiver).
- 5. Replace wax guards once a month or as needed.
